## Taking care of your new tree

Please help us look after your new tree by:

- ✓ Watering it regularly - particularly in the drier months.
- ✓ Keep the base weed free and mulched but keep mulch away from the tree trunk

### Please DO NOT

- ✗ Use grass clippings as mulch, as grass clippings damages the tree
- ✗ Use spray containing herbicides/pesticides
- ✗ Do not damage trees with cars.
