Underwater Diorama

What you need:

- Tissue box
- Paint and paintbrush
- Paper
- Pencils/textas
- Something to hang the underwater creatures with
- Scissors
- Sticky tape

What to do:

- Cut the top off the tissue box. Paint the box so it looks like an underwater scene. I used greens and blues to paint all over the box. The part of the box that is the ocean floor, I painted it yellow and brown. Leave to dry
- On the paper, draw things for your diorama. You can draw underwater creatures, and scenery like rocks, coral and seaweed. Cut these out. Don't draw them too big, you want them to fit in the tissue box.
- Stick the scenery you just cut out in the box. With my coral, I folded the end and use tape to stick it down so it stands up.
- Cut pieces of string and stick to the back of the sea creatures. Stick onto the top of the tissue box, cutting the string so you are happy with how it looks. If you use a different length of string for each sea creature, then it adds more depth.
