Paper Plate Olympic Rings





What you need:

- 5 paper plates
- Scissors
- Colouring supplies
- Sticky tape

What to do:

- 1. Colour the outside ring of each plate in blue, yellow, black, green and red.
- 2. Now cut the middle part of the plate out. To do this, cut through the ring like in the picture, then cut out the middle circle.





3. Thread the yellow ring through the blue and use tape to close the cut you made to remove the middle of the plate. Now attach the black plate to the yellow. Then the green to the black and the red to the green.



4. You should have all 5 plates linked in the order in the picture below.



5. Move the plates around so they sit the same as the Olympic rings. Look at the picture below. Show us your Olympic rings on the <u>Kids Club Online Gallery.</u>
