Olympic Torch

What you need:

- Cardboard roll (save the rolls from empty paper towel, baking paper and foil for craft projects like this one)
- Paper plate
- Paper
- Colour pencils/textas
- Sticky Tape
- Scissors

What to do:


- 1. Colour in your cardboard roll. You can use paper or colour in with pencils or textas. If you don't have a cardboard roll, you can roll up paper to make one. This will be the base of your torch.
- 2. Colour in the paper plate. Mark the middle of the plate. Then draw a line from the middle to the edge, like in picture #2. Cut along this line.
- 3. Fold the plate up so it is in a cone shape like in picture #3. Use sticky tape to hold it together.
- 4. Cut the bottom of the plate, where it makes a point. The plate will be the head of the torch.
- 5. Draw a lot of large flame shapes, colour in and cut out. I used about 20 for my torch.













- 6. Using sticky tape, stick the flames inside the paper plate and arrange them so they fan out, like in picture #6.
- 7. When you are happy with how the flames look, attach the head of the torch to the base using sticky tape. The tip that you cut off in Step 4 makes the head of the torch flat so you can attach it to the base easier. Make sure the head is securely on the base of the torch.
