In my art, I focus predominantly on women who endure the shackles of religious tyranny, deprived of their freedom. Through each stroke of my brush, I strive to give voice to their silenced stories, shedding light on their struggles and resilience. My paintings serve as a call to action, urging viewers to confront injustice and champion the cause of liberation. 
NEST is a fun 6-week cooking and nutrition program designed to help you make lasting changes for better health!

A BEACON OF COMMUNITY GROWTH AND CONNECTIONS

For approximately 8 years, Monica's early years programs Little Kookies, Busy Bees, Saltwater Playgroup have been a cornerstone of the community, offering a nurturing environment for families and children up to four years old. With a presence at our Featherbrook and Saltwater Community Centres, these Playgroups, Story time and Rhyme time weekly sessions have become a vital part of the community fabric, providing countless benefits to families and Mums in Point Cook.

Monica's journey began in 2016, when she was seeking activities for her two young children and, as an immigrant from Romania, eager to connect with like-minded people. During her Maternal Child & Health appointments, she discovered a community playgroup at her local Community Centre. Unfortunately, the parent-led program soon closed due to the common turnover of key volunteers. Despite her worries about communication and her Romanian accent, Monica, was motivated by her children and supported by her husband, so she took a leap of faith and the rest is history. And boy, are we ever so grateful that she did!!

Today Monica's playgroup is thriving with three sessions weekly across two Point Cook Centres. Recognised for her successful and meaningful programming, Monica was invited by the Middleton Drive Kindergarten, also known as Sparkways Early Learning, to support local families prepare the children for Kinder.

The success of Monica's programs has been identified as a referral pathway to a supportive community partner, fostering growth and development for families. Monica focuses on early childhood development through engaging and supportive environments for both children and parents. Children are encouraged to explore and interact, building cognitive and social skills. Parents and Carers who have often felt isolated, have developed meaningful connections and built supportive networks as a result.

"Monica is fantastic, and the playgroup she runs is unlike any other we've attended. We've tried various groups, including church and community-run ones, but her model stands out. It works better for everyone, attracting and engaging many parents and children."

For many years now, Monica's playgroups have consistently upheld high-quality standards as a community-driven initiative aligned with Australia's Early Years Learning Framework (EYLF) Little Kookies and Busy Bees embody these standards, enriching the community through each playdate.



Monica is amazing, my daughter absolutely adores her I doubt we would attend as often/at all if we didn't have a facilitator that we loved and than engages so beautifully with the children.

We are thrilled to have discovered this playgroup and Monica. We've tried other groups in the area, but Monica's facilitation makes this one an exceptionally positive experience. My child has additional needs, and this group motivates us to get out of the house, knowing we'll have a great day.

Monica is amazing! We need her to maintain the play group & support our local community.

Monica has been a saviour for me as a first time Mother. Monica's group has allowed me to social with other mums whilst watching my daughter develop her skills and friendships. My daughter gets excited every week knowing she is going to see Monica and do activities we wouldn't usually do at home. And every child looks forward to the stamp at the end.

As a primary teacher with 20+years experience. I rate this playgroup & Monica very highly. The activities vary from week to week whilst still maintaining consistency so that and safe to play, develop their free play and the story shared s wonderful.
