Ramadan Geometric Garland



Make a beautiful paper cut garland for Ramadan. All you need is paper and scissors.



Position the paper so the long edge is at the bottom.



Fold down the top edge so that it ends up about 2cm from the bottom edge.



Pick up the top piece of paper and fold it up to the top edge.



Cut parallel lines about 2cm apart. Cut from the bottom edge, ending about 1cm from the top edge.



Continue along the page.



Turn the paper around so the long slits are at the top. Make small cuts between the slits, ending about half a cm from the folded edge. Continue along the page.

Gently unfold and tease apart the paper. Now your garland is ready to hang! Show us what you have made on the <u>Kids Creations Gallery</u>.
