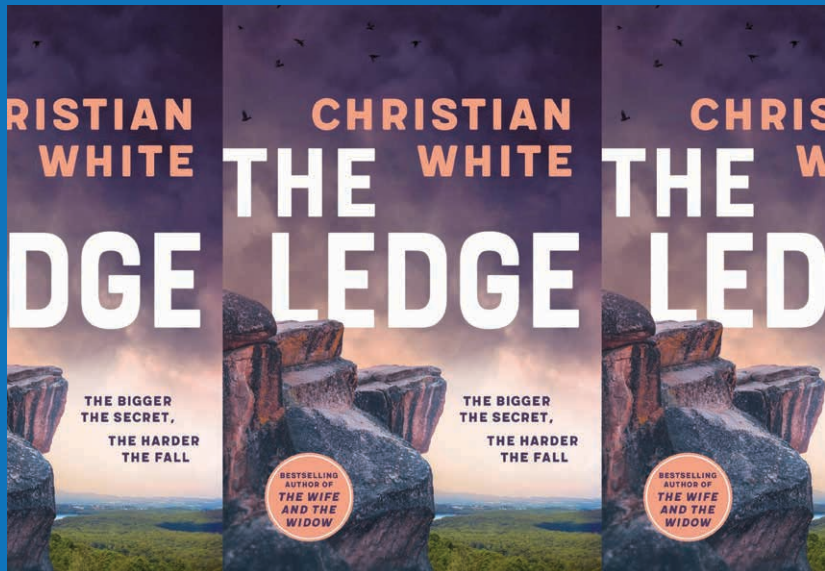


Werribee Library Reopening

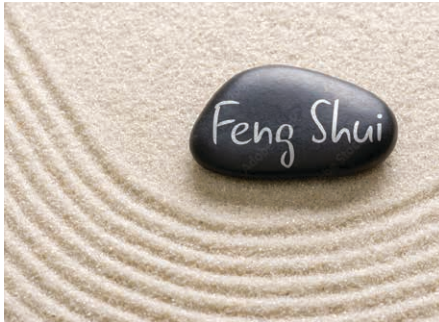
