



MANDALORIAN PATH THIS IS THE WAY

Follow these rules of Mandalore:

Wear armour: Dress up as a Mandalorian. You can make your costume yourself or you might have a purchased costume.

DIY your costume by wearing black jeans and a black t-shirt. Decorate your outfit with foil armour and use black material for a cape. You could use a silver/grey beanie as your Mandalorian Helmet—remember you cannot take it off!

Speaking the language: The Mandalorian never raises his voice, even in stressful situations. Practise keeping your voice even and at a normal level at all times. This is the way!

Defending yourself and your family: Get an egg and draw baby yoda’s face on it. You must now look after this egg all day and all night and pretend it is the real Grogu. You cannot leave it alone....ever. So, if you can’t look after it yourself, make sure to get a babysitter. Keep it warm and don’t drop it! Can you look after your baby yoda egg all day?
