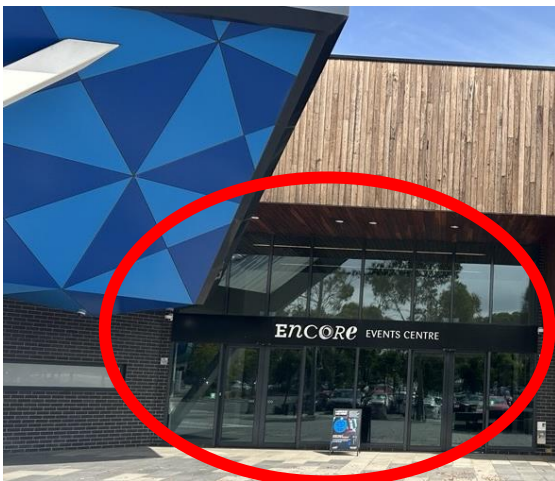
Your support person can also help you to register.
